## REQUEST

A note from Linda about Cyclone Idai:

"It's still very, very bad here. We have never been hit the way the floods hit us this year; the crops were washed away with the floods. A lot of houses fell down; most of our pastors have lost their homes and most of their belongings, even though they didn't have much.

People are still without food and houses. Rains are still coming, but not as heavy. People can't mold bricks right now because the ground is too wet, and it's still raining.

The situation is very, very sad. It's just too much. In the past, there was drought, then floods. Last year we had 50/50 because we also had bugs eating the maize crops, so some areas harvested well and others didn't. This year we have been hit so bad. It was raining heavily, most of the areas got floods; plus we had very strong winds.

Our faith is still strong and we know God is with us. We know that whatever has happened to us is not going to affect our faith because we know that no matter what happens, nothing will separate us from the love of God that he has for us. Thank you so much for all that you are doing. May God bless you."
