## AFRICA TRIP UPDATE

On May 21<sup>st</sup>, a team of four set out on a mission trip to Africa. The team is led by Joe and Rebekah Martin and they are being accompanied by Jacob Rohrer and Rollin Carlbloom. The plan was to travel to Malawi, Mozambique, and Kenya, but they were not able to obtain visas to go to Mozambique. They were able to meet with many Mozambique pastors in Malawi instead. The focus of the trip is to meet with pastors to train and encourage them, hold several church services, and distribute Bibles and other items that were donated through the LHI Missions Catalog. They will return home on July 3<sup>rd</sup>.
