

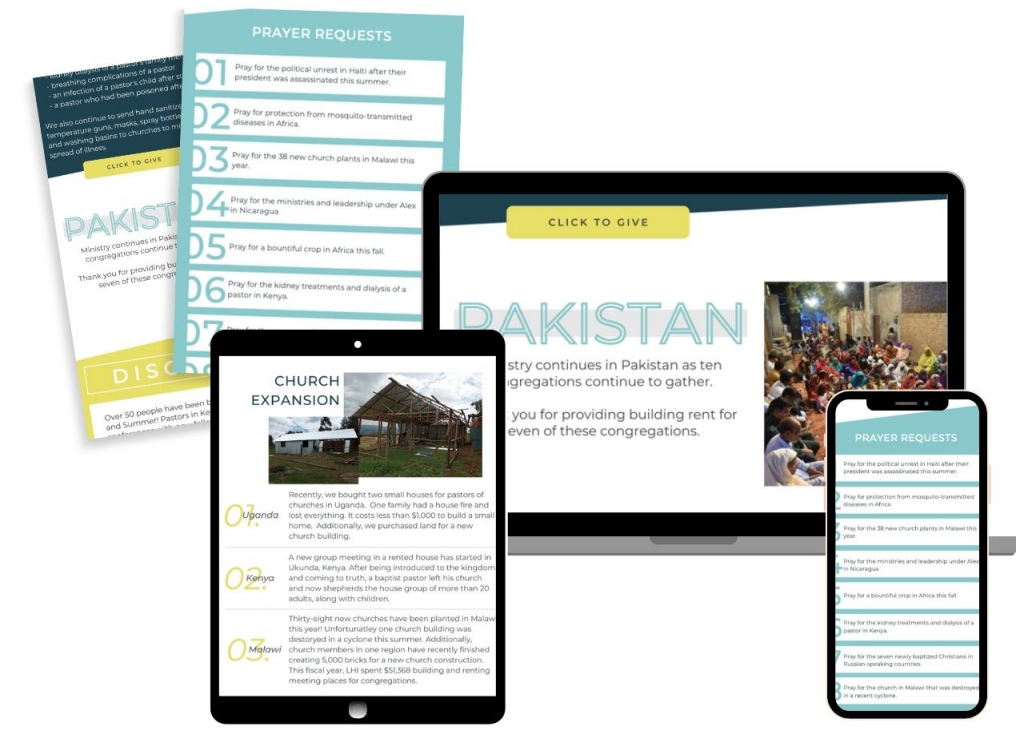

### A Year in Russia



**Thank you so much for believing and about brothers and sisters!**

- BIBLES**  
This year, Maksim bought and distributed 15-25 Bibles each month.
- BOOKS**  
One-thousand copies of Dan Gill's book, "The One" were printed in Russian this year.
- BAPTISMS**  
Maksim baptized seven people this past year. Overall, 39 people have been baptized!

## CHURCH EXPANSION



### 01. Uganda

Recently, we bought two small houses for pastors of churches in Uganda. One family had a house fire and lost everything. It costs less than \$1,000 to build a small home. Additionally, we purchased land for a new church building.

### 02. Kenya

A new group meeting in a rented house has started in Ukunda, Kenya. After being introduced to the kingdom and coming to truth, a baptist pastor left his church and now shepherds the house group of more than 20 adults, along with children.

### 03. Malawi

Thirty-eight new churches have been planted in Malawi this year! Unfortunatley one church building was destroyed in a cyclone this summer. Additionally, church members in one region have recently finished creating 5,000 bricks for a new church construction. This fiscal year, LHI spent \$51,368 building and renting meeting places for congregations.

## HOSPITALIZATIONS

This summer, LHI paid medical expenses for:

- a newborn fighting pneumonia
- an orphan with malaria
- an emergency c-section of a pastor's wife
- a pastor's child fighting measles
- treatment of a brain tumor of a pastor's child
- kidney dialysis of a pastor's family member
- breathing complications of a pastor
- an infection of a pastor's child after stabbed
- a pastor who had been poisoned

We also continue to send hand sanitizer, temperature guns, masks, spray bottles, hand soap and washing basins to churches to mitigate the spread of illness.



This fiscal year, we sent \$5,246 on emergency medical procedures.

\$2,000 of this included mosquito nets.

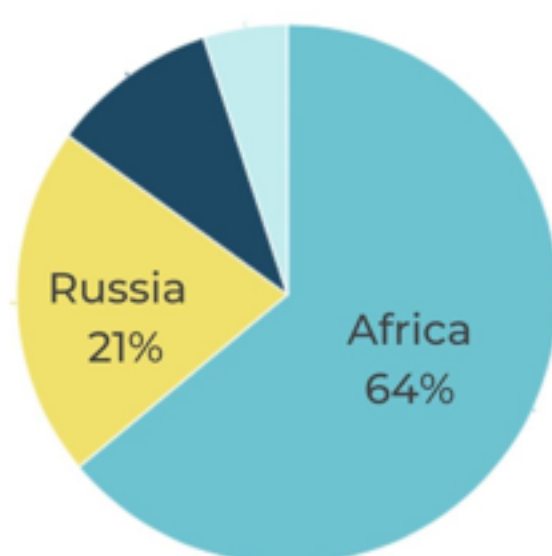
